



1) Come to class once or twice a week.



2a) Do the Gideon homework each day. Be consistent!

2b) Grade your child's math drill work that is done at home each day.



3) Listen to your child read letter names/sounds or their oral reading lists.



4) Math: Practice oral facts by having your student just say the answers from the math drill booklet's front inside cover. **SPEED + ACCURACY = MATH MASTERY**



5a) Reread directions and passages.

5b) Watch the details! Tell your student to review his work to ensure that each sentence has a capital letter and ending punctuation and spelling is correct with legible handwriting.



6) Be patient with new concepts and/or repetitions of booklets. **BELIEVE IN YOUR CHILD!**



7) Communicate any concerns with your center director.



8) Communicate to your child that YOU are always in charge.



9) Avoid or eliminate breaks.
